

# Gila Native Plant Society Bylaws

## ARTICLE I – NAME

The name of this organization shall be the Gila Native Plant Society (GNPS).

## ARTICLE III - MEMBERSHIP

d. Membership dues of the Gila Native Plant Society shall be those determined by the Board of Directors of the Native Plant Society of New Mexico (NPSNM). Dues not renewed within two months after the anniversary/renewal date shall be considered delinquent and the member shall be dropped from the membership roll. Each member shall have one vote in the election of members to the Board of Directors of GNPS.

## ARTICLE V. OFFICERS

a. Officers of this organization shall be President, Vice-President, Secretary, and Treasurer.

b. The term of office for an officer or member of the Board shall be two years.

c. Should the President be unable to complete the term of office, the Vice President shall assume the office and duties of the President.

d. Should the Vice President, Secretary, or Treasurer be unable to complete the term of office, a replacement shall be appointed by the President to serve the remainder of the unexpired term.

## ARTICLE VI. DUTIES OF THE OFFICERS OF GNPS

The officers shall also be Directors of GNPS. General duties of the officers are:

President: The President shall provide direction to the Society, be the chief spokesperson to the community, preside at meetings, appoint special committees and perform other duties as determined by the Board of Directors from time to time. In addition, to provide leadership continuity, the President will be expected to serve a two year term as Past President on the Board of Directors.

Vice-President: The Vice-President shall arrange for programs at the monthly meetings, preside at meetings when the President is unavailable, and perform other duties as the President, or the Board of Directors, may request from time to time.

Treasurer: The Treasurer shall keep the accounting records of the GNPS, deposit and disperse monies as necessary, produce such financial statements as are required by various organizations, periodically report the financial condition to the Board and perform such other tasks as the Board of Directors or the President may request.
