

Meadow Creek

Located in the Pinos Altos Range, Gila National Forest. Elevation 7200'. Habitats: Riparian; east facing mesic slopes; xeric western slopes; rock outcroppings.

Directions: from Silver City take NM Hwy 15 north for 6 miles to Pinos Altos, continue N on NM Hwy 15 for 8.3 miles. The Meadow Creek turnoff (FS Rd 149) is to the right and then 3 miles on the dirt road to a suitable parking area. Travel time, one way from Silver City, approx. 40 minutes.
