1. Ethnobotany Garden

5. Mariposa Pavilion

Enjoy a shady place to rest during your visit or attend a scheduled educational program offered by the Gila Native Plant Society.

6. Front Yard Garden

Admire seasonal blooms from hardy, New Mexico native perennials and wildflowers.

7. Cactus and Succulents Garden

Showcasing the amazing diversity of sharp, spiny, and stunning plants of the region.

8. Chihuahuan Desert Grassland

Highlighting native grasses and the amazing sculptural forms of yucca, sotol, and agave, this garden also exhibits work form local artists.

9. Memorial Wall

This historic railroad water tank once served mining operations and is now the icon of the Silva Creek Botanical Garden. A memorial wall commemorates cherished members of our community.

10. Bird Thicket

Learn how to create effective wildlife habitat, in particular, to attract birds to your backyard.

11. Riparian Alley

These earthworks help to slow and redirect storm water in order to protect other areas of the garden and create the perfect conditions for arid-riparian plants to grow.
